

LEAVE RULES

1. If a student is absent from school due to genuine reason he/she should submit a leave application duly signed by the parent on the day he/she rejoins school. The mobile app of the school also has the feature of intimating the school authorities regarding leave.
2. A student's name is liable to be struck off the school rolls if he/she absents himself/herself for five consecutive working days without intimation or prior permission. Re-admission in such cases may be granted on the merit of the case and on payment of re-admission fee.
3. Whenever a child is suffering from measles or any contagious disease, he/she should not be sent to school unless fitness certificate is issued by the Doctor.

SCHEME OF STUDIES

1. The school will follow CBSE curriculum outline for both Scholastic and Co- Scholastic areas. However, curriculum for the toddlers in the Playschool & Kindergarten will be designed to develop the Cognitive, Linguistic & Numerical skills of the students besides targeting development of the Affective domain (social and inter-personal relations) as well as Psychomotor Skills (including kinaesthetic skills, music and computers).
2. English will be the Medium of instruction at Narula Public School & special impetus will be given to polish the communication skills of the students in English.
3. Bengali/Hindi are taught as second Language from class I upwards. Hindi / Bengali are also taught as third language from class V-VIII for students who opt for Bengali / Hindi as second language respectively.
4. Remediation & Support: Based on the principle of differentiation & differentiated instruction, one period each (need based) will be utilized daily for reflection, support & remediation.
