General Rules of Talent Hunt Contest:

1. All events will be conducted through virtual mode.
2. The participants are requested to submit their entries within the stipulated time frame.
3. Complete entries for all the events should be mailed as per instructions at springfestnps@gmail.com .
4. Participating school/student should register through google form <https://forms.gle/2shTEKn8XCqaH22X7> latest by Feb 9, 2021.
5. Last date of receiving entries is Feb16,2021.
6. Out of the total entries received, the best four entries selected by the judges will be posted on the school Facebook page on Feb19,2021. Based on the number of likes by viewers on FB till Feb23,2021 noon time, 1st, 2nd, 3rd & consolation prize winners will be declared in each category on the social media handles of Narula Public School on Feb23,2021.
7. Position holders will be conferred with e-Certificates. Their creative work will be published on social media platforms of Narula Public School. When schools reopen, they will be invited to the school for Prize distribution ceremony.
8. E-Certificates will be awarded to all the participants.
9. Name of the participant, school, event, category, and class must be mentioned as text in the forwarding note of the email used to send attachments of entries. **The same should not be visible on any picture/ attachment/entry.**
10. Any participant found violating the rules and regulations will be disqualified from the competition.

Event: Costume Designing/Fancy Dress Competition

Nb. Of Participants: One/Individual; **Registration Deadline:** Feb9,2021

Deadline of Submission of entries: Feb16,2021 latest by 5pm.

Mode of e-submission: Photograph in .jpg format through email

Themes: 1. Jai Jawan Jai Kisan; 2. This is what I want to be...

Categories:

- Elementary (3-8years): Nursery to Grade 2
- Primary (9-12 years): Grade 3 to Grade 5
- Upper Primary (13-15 years): Grade 6 to Grade 8

Rules:

1. The participant should dress up using recycled materials on any one of the themes given above.
2. Entries should be shared through mail at springfestnps@gmail.com latest by Feb16,2021. The subject line of the mail should be **Attire Speaks**. Name of the participant, school, event, category, class & 2 sentences on recycled materials used in the costume must be mentioned as text in the forwarding note of the email used to send attachment of entry. **The same should not be visible on any picture/attachment/entry.**
3. Marks will be allotted for relevant backdrop, originality of idea, use of recycled materials and visual quality of the picture.

Judgement Criteria:

1. Relevance to theme
2. Creativity (Design of the costume, use of artwork & props)
3. Presentation & visual quality of the photograph
